## CONCLUSION

This year's cohort consisted of 30+ enterprise-ready, digital health startups that were prepared to work on demonstration projects with our Champions. Our overarching goal for 2019 was strengthening our core program to enhance our Goals and Milestones achievement, which we accomplished. We saw over 72% of program goals hit by the end of the program (an increase from 66% last year), with 40+ pilots to be launched by end of year. This shows that the startups matched successfully to engage their Champions, collaborate to solve challenges, and continue to foster working relationships that will last beyond the program.

For the 2020 program, we plan to integrate internal and third party research findings into our core program to further improve our support of startups and become more evidence-based by 2025. We will continue to grow our ability to establish meaningful partnerships, support entrepreneurs, drive successful patient outcomes, and solve massive challenges in healthcare.
